Foundation Announces Grants 2018



In its seventh year of funding proposals submitted by staff members for their departments, **Passavant Hospital Foundation** announced that 20 projects are being funded, thanks to a partnership among the Foundation, the **Auxiliary** and the **Hospital** itself.

The **20 projects** funded range in cost from \$850 to \$52,750 for a total of **\$232,224**.

Every project funded improves patient diagnosis, treatment, comfort and/or safety or significantly improves the working environment for staff.

The Foundation's Mission Support Committee vetted the proposals.
